Know Your Blood Sugar Numbers - National Institute of ...

- Check your blood sugar as many times a day as your health care team suggests
- Have your A1C checked at least 2 times a year
- Keep a record of your blood sugar and A1C numbers
- Take your blood glucose meter and blood sugar record to your visit and show them to your health care team

Tell your health care team how you think you
